

Overview

In FileNexus version 5.326.xx and higher, you have the ability to use Active Directory or LDAP login authentication in lieu of relying on the user's FileNexus password to login to FileNexus applications.

What this means to you, the FileNexus Administrator

Your users will no longer need to keep track of an additional password for FileNexus, separate from their Windows network login password. If you employ Active Directory in your organization, users will be able to login to FileNexus using the same login they use for your Windows network. Therefore, if their Windows password changes, you can avoid having to make the same changes to their FileNexus passwords.
